

TERM 2 CURRICULUM OVERVIEW - PREP 2023 -



ENGLISH

Enjoying and Retelling Stories

In this unit, the focus will be:

- listening to and engaging with a range of literary and non-literary texts with a focus on how language is used to entertain through retelling events. They engage in multiple opportunities to learn about language, literature and literacy.
- sequencing events from a range of texts, including stories from Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander peoples, and retell a favourite story to a small group of classmates. They will prepare for their spoken retell by drawing events in sequence and writing simple sentences.

During our Prep Year level literacy block, students will participate in sound and word study activities, plus shared and modelled reading and writing sessions 4 days per week.

SCIENCE

Our Material World

In this unit our focus will be:

 describing the observable properties of materials from which an object is made.
 Student will identify suitability of materials for purpose. They ask and respond to questions and share and reflect on observations.
