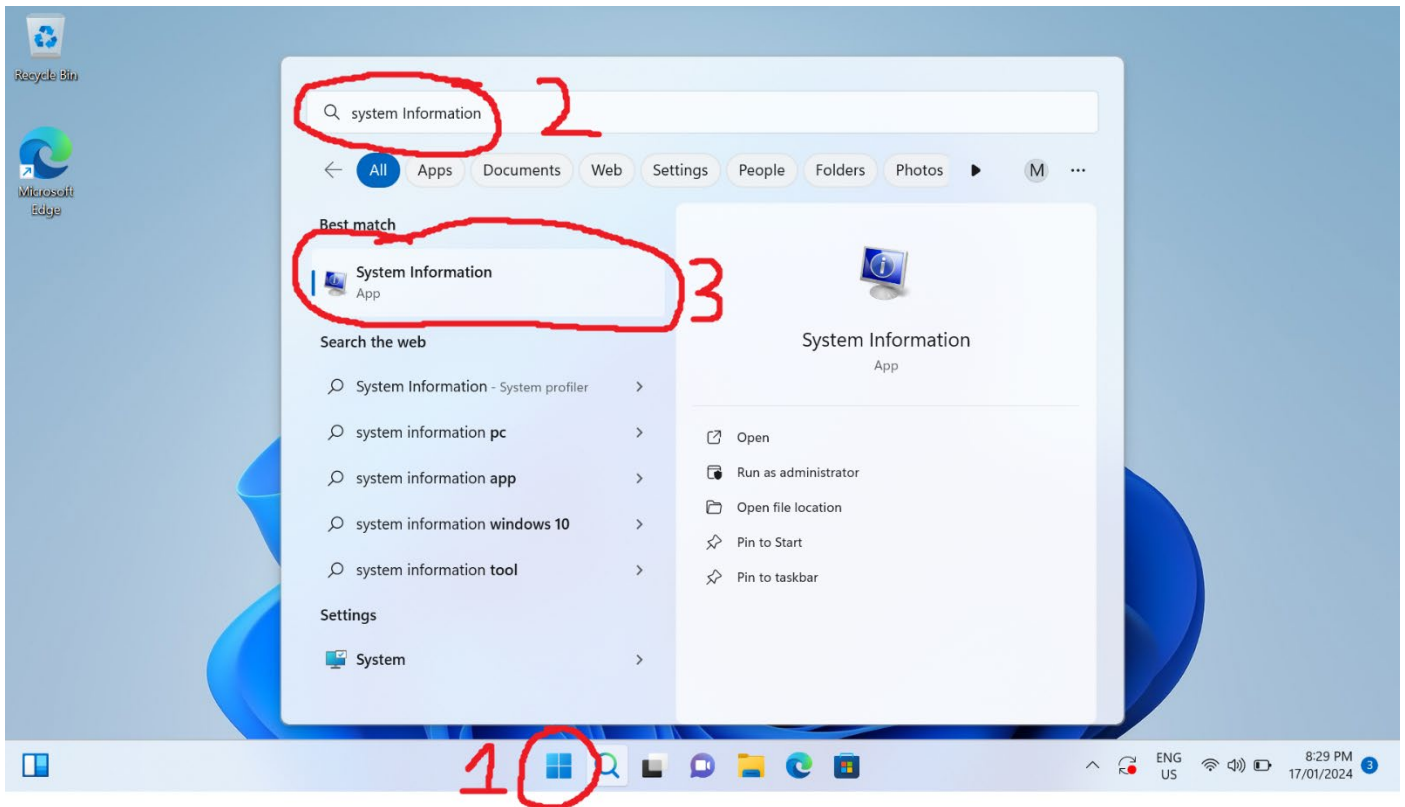
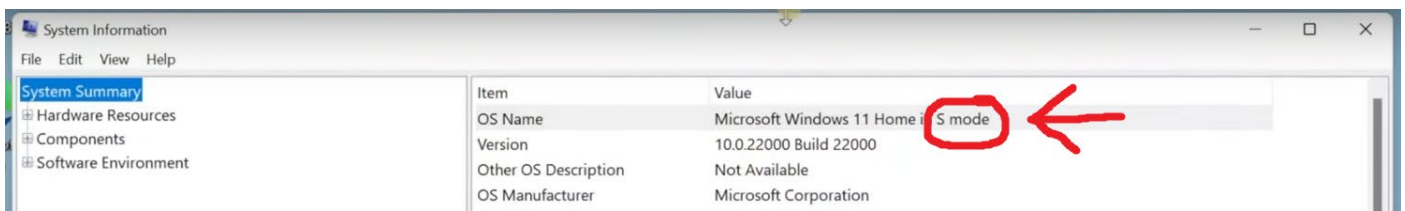


BYOD Windows 11

2. At the top of the start screen there is a search bar type **System information** and open the program.

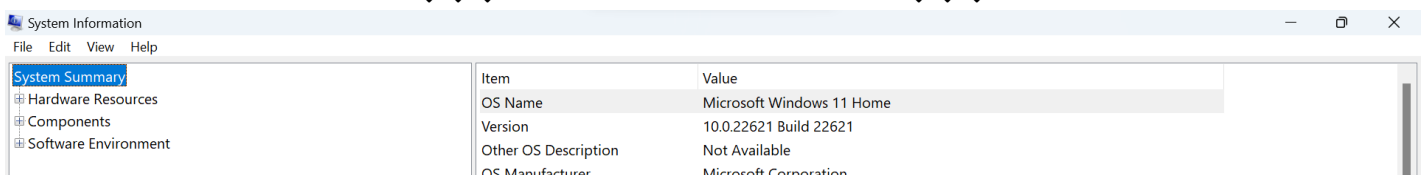


3. In the 1st row it will say Microsoft windows 11. If it has **S mode** on the end of that, please look at how to switch out of S mode document be for continuing.

↓↓↓9 Window 11 Out of S mode ↓↓↓

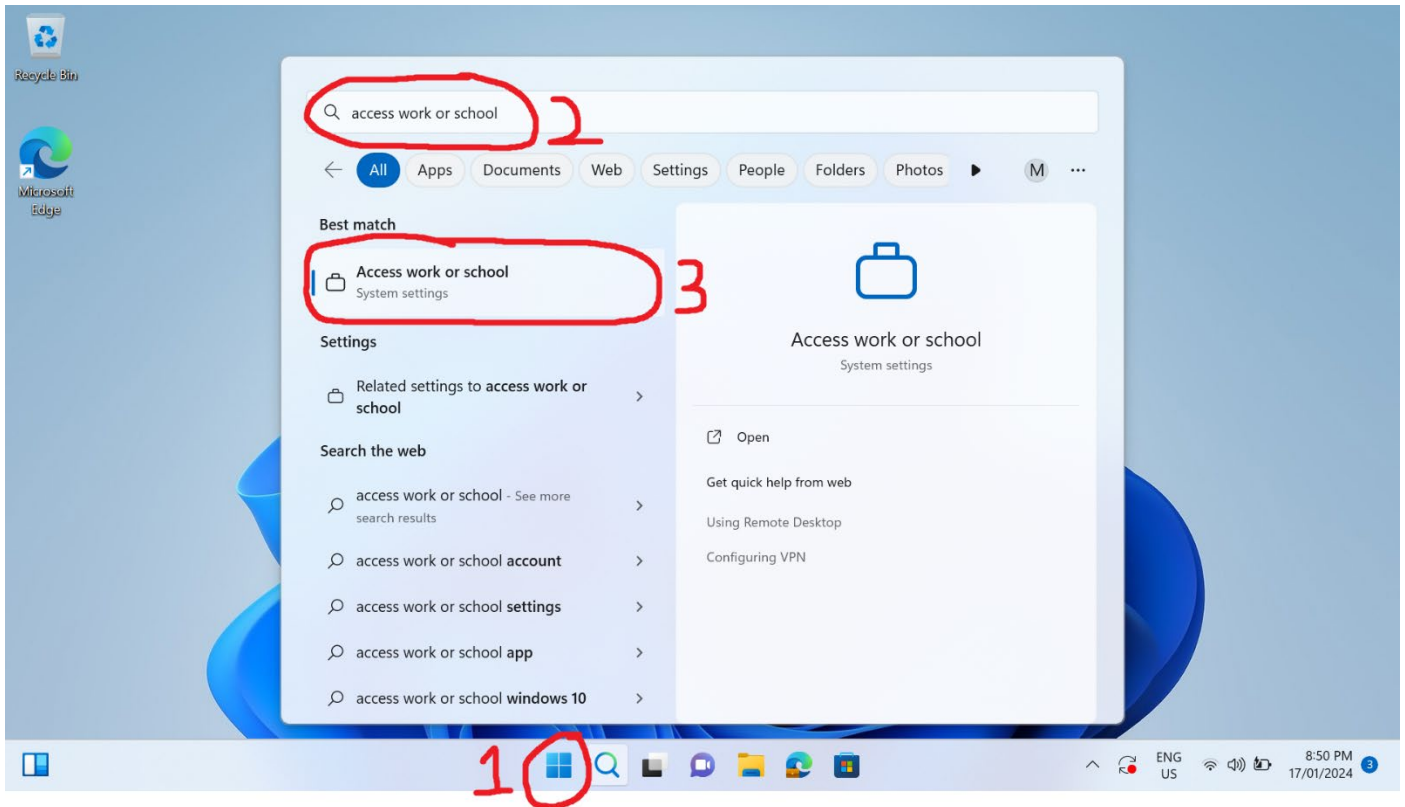


If you do not have windows 11 S mode you may close this window and continue to the next steps.

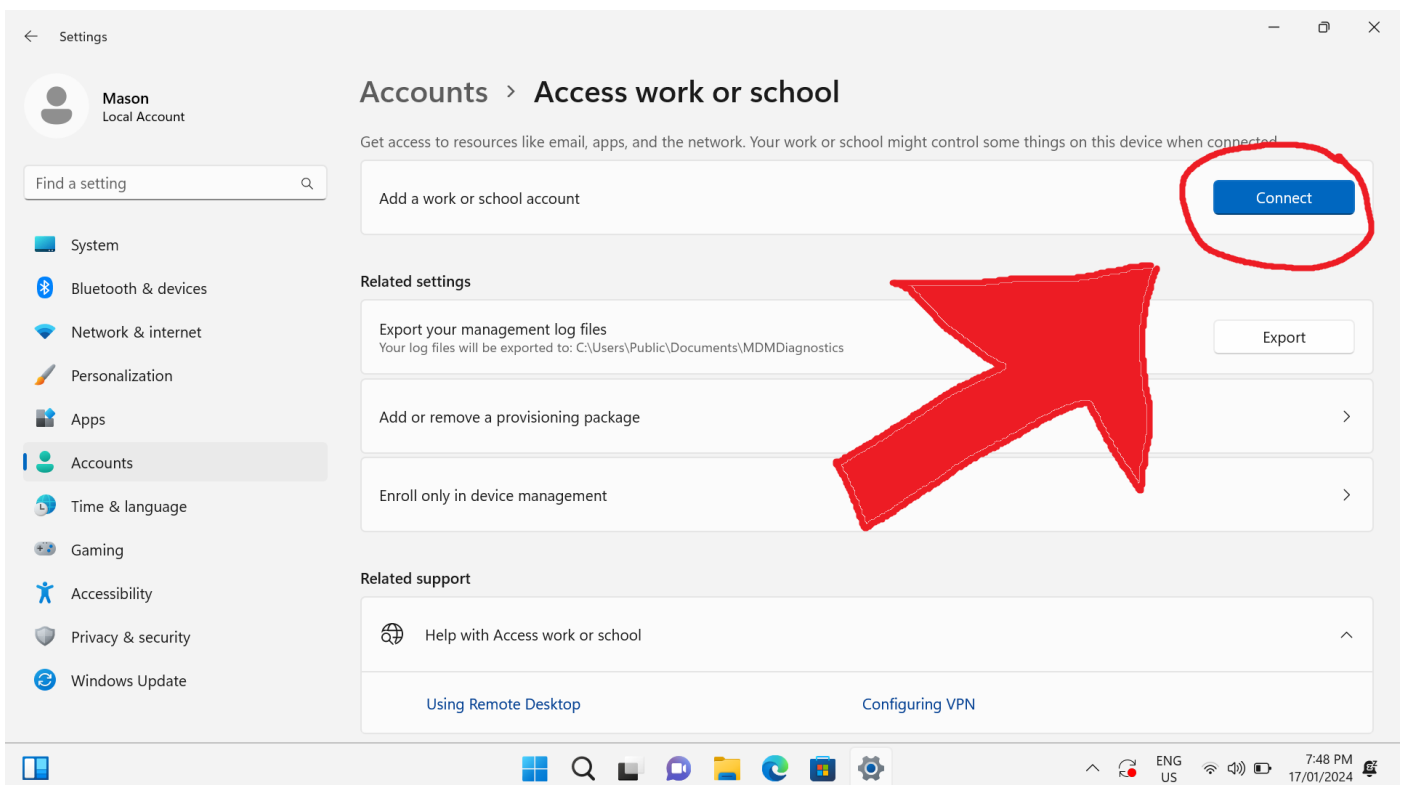
