BYO iPad Program – One to One Learning

Students in Years 3 to 6 attending Upper Coomera State College will be expected to have a personal iPad to be used at school as part of their educational instruction.

iPad Minimum Specifications

The iPad must be one of the following and support iPadOS 16

- iPad 5th Gen or later
- iPad Pro (12.9 inch 3rd Gen or later, 11 inch 1st Gen or later, 10.5 inch 1st Gen or later, 9.7 inch 1st Gen or later)

**(iPads outside the above specifications will not be permitted to access the College Wi-Fi network).

✓ The battery life must exceed 4 hours and a quality case and keyboard is essential.

✓ All storage versions are supported in the BYOD program at UCSC − 32GB, 64GB, 128GB.

✓ you at home (Internet access is via wireless).

Connectivity

iPads which meet the above minimum requirements will have access to WIFI. Internet filtering solutions restrict access to inappropriate materials whilst connected to the school's wireless network.

Required Apps

Each privately owned iPad in the BYO Program will require necessary apps to be installed. Full instructions will be made available to parents to assist with this process.

Safety and Security of BYO iPads

- Students are responsible for the security of their iPad to and from school
- Students who arrive before the start of the school day will keep their iPad in their school bag until they go to class and their teacher directs them to take it out
- Students will lock their iPad within the classroom during break times and specialist lessons, each classroom has a lockable filing cabinet for safe storage
- A quality cover and keyboard will help protect your child's iPad

Prep, Year 1 and Year 2 iPad Program (School Provided)

Shared devices within the classroom will be provided by the College as part of Student Resource Scheme (SRS). Students will also have access to iPads in their lessons in the Digital Creative Play Learning Centre. The digital platform of SeeSaw will be utilised for students to store their digital portfolio.
