ENGLISH

Expressing a preference for a character

In this unit, the focus will be:

- read, view and listen to a variety of literary texts to explore how characters are represented in print and images. Students identify character qualities in texts. They compare how similar characters are depicted in two literary texts and write a text expressing a preference for one character, giving reasons.

During our Year level literacy block, students will participate in four weekly sessions of daily reading, as well as word study activities and dictation.

In this unit, the focus will be:

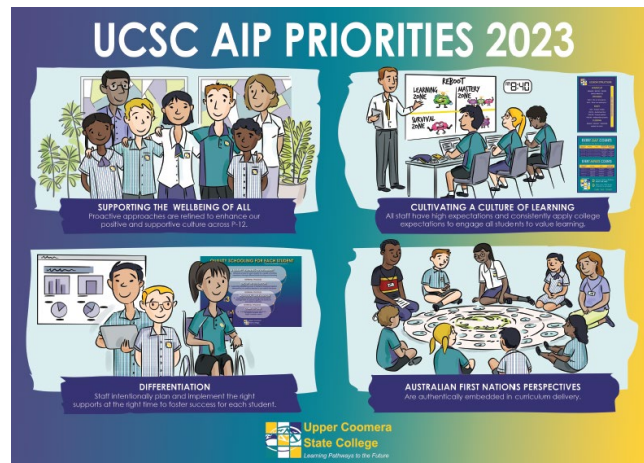
- understand how a push or pull, affects how an object moves or changes shape.
