ENGLISH

Traditional Stories

In this unit, the focus will be:

- read and analyse traditional stories from Asia and from Aboriginal peoples' and Torres Strait Islander peoples' histories and cultures.
- demonstrate understanding of the stories by identifying structural and language features, finding literal and inferred meaning and explaining the message or moral.
- plan, create and present a traditional story which includes a moral for a younger audience
During our year level literacy block, students will participate in four weekly sessions of daily reading, including required intervention, PLD Spelling and dictation.

SCIENCE

Mapping life cycles and relationships

In this unit, the focus will be:

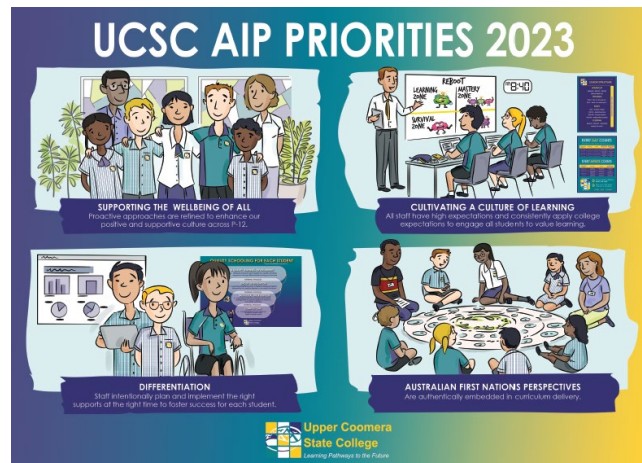
- investigate life cycles and sequence key stages in the life cycles of plants and animals. They examine relationships between living things and their dependence on each other and on the environment.
