



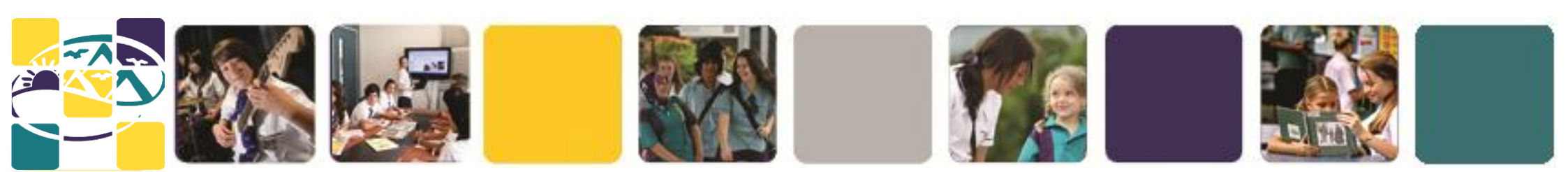
How to join the DETE WiFi network with an Apple Mac

The examples below use screen shots from an MacBook running operating system iOS 10.9.1

This guide explains how to manually set up a WiFi connection to the DETE network.

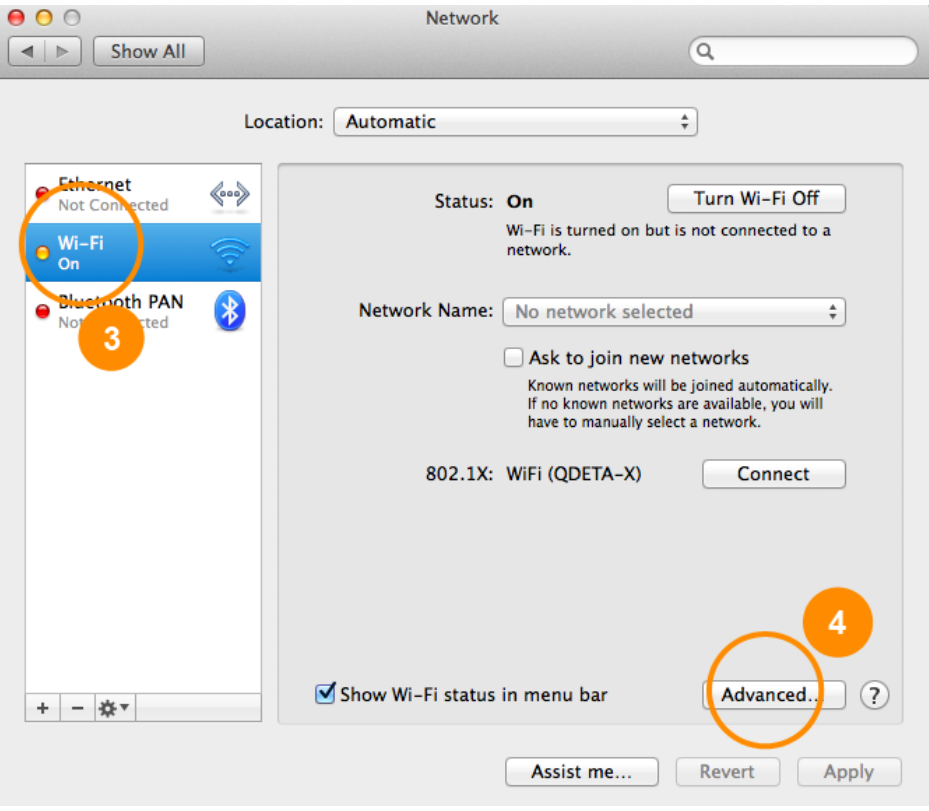
1. Open **System Preferences**
2. Click on the **Network** icon

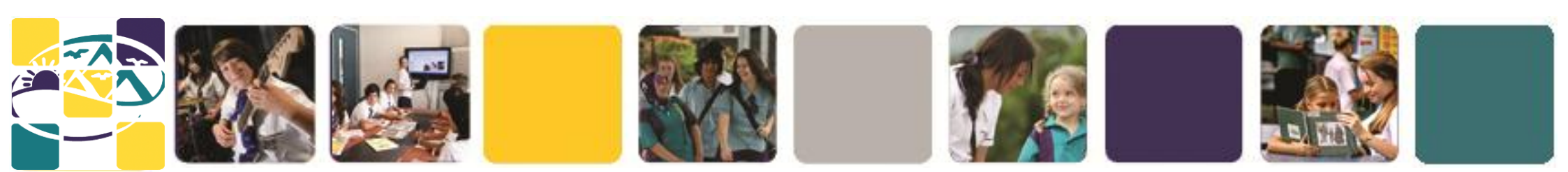




Note: there are two possible DETE WiFi network names. All schools will have the older **QDETA-X** while schools with the updated wireless access points will have both **QDETA-X** and the newer **iDET** (*check with your school technician to see if you can access iDET*)

- 3. Highlight the **Wi-Fi** option
- 4. Click the **Advanced** button





5. Click on the + symbol
6. Enter required information as shown
 - o Network Name **iDET**
 - o Security **WPA/WPA2 Enterprise**
 - o Mode **Automatic**
 - o Username **DETE Username**
 - o Password **DETE Password**
7. Click the **OK** button

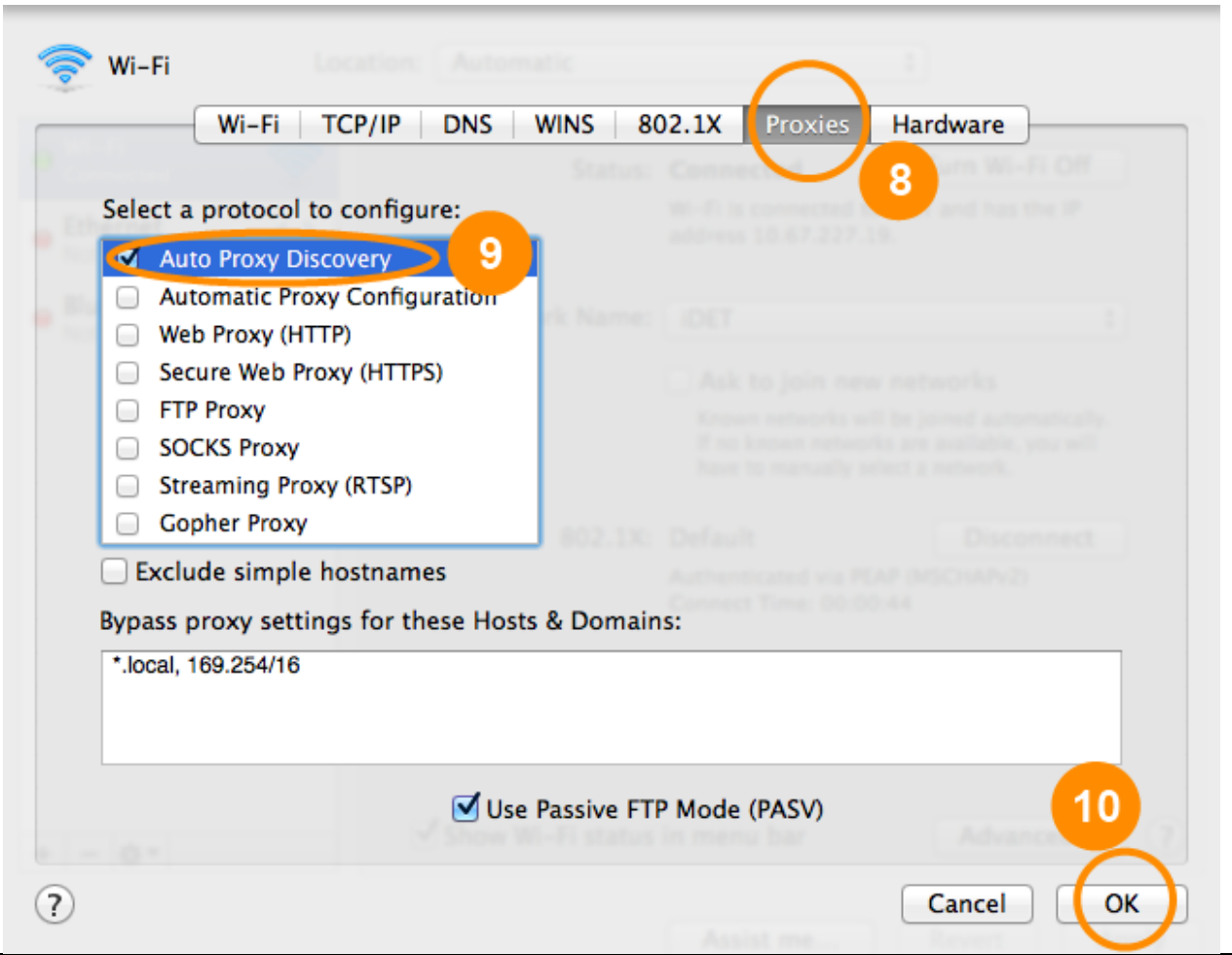

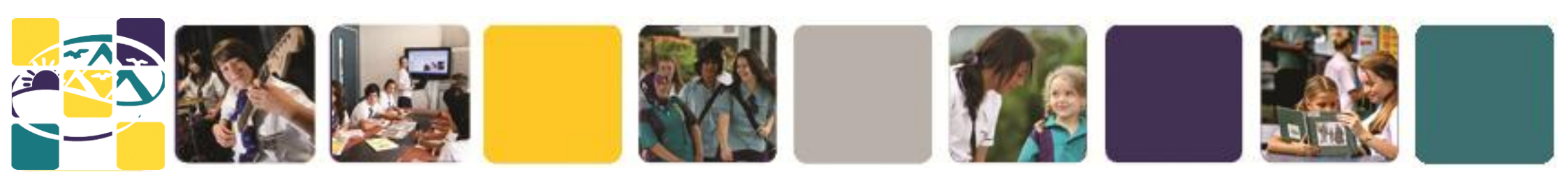

8. Click on the **Proxies** tab
9. Tick the **Auto Proxy Discovery** option
10. Click the **OK** button





After step 10 you will be prompted for your iDET credentials

- 11. Enter your **DETE Username**
- 12. Enter your **DETE Password**
- 13. Click the **OK** button
- 14. Upon successful connection the Wi-Fi icon will appear solid
